

## NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A ZONING BY-LAW BY THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTHWOLD

## **Application ZBA 2025-02**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Southwold passed Bylaw No. 2025-12 on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2025, pursuant to Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

The subject lands are legally described as: Concession North North Branch Talbot Road S Part of Lot 34 and 35, (NNBTR), Geographic Township of Southwold, Elgin County, located at 39024 Talbot Line, St. Thomas, as shown on the key map on the **back** of this notice.

**THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT** of the By-law was to rezone the subject lands from Residential 1 (R1) Zone to Residential 1 with a Special Provision 39 (R1-39) Zone to permit a home occupation (Dog Groomer) within an accessory structure and occupying an area of approximately 100 m<sup>2</sup> (1080 ft<sup>2</sup>).

The Written and Oral Submissions are summarized in the Planning Staff Report PLA 2025-06 and in the Statutory Public Meeting portion of the Council Meeting minutes of February 24, 2025; and were considered as part of the effect on the decision-making process.

**AND TAKE NOTICE** that those afforded rights to appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal under Section 34(19) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, may appeal the decision of Council with respect to the By-law by filing a Notice of Appeal with the Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Southwold, no later than **March 17, 2025.** The Notice of Appeal shall set out the objection to the by-law, the reasons in support of the objection, and shall be accompanied by a copy of the appeal form, available from the Ontario Land Tribunal website at www.elto.gov.on.ca, other documents and the fee required by the Tribunal (certified cheque, money order or credit card) payable to the Ministry of Finance and in Canadian funds. Upon receipt by the Clerk, the Notice of Appeal package will be forwarded to the Ontario Land Tribunal.

No person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.


