Housing-Enabled Water Systems Fund Announcement

During the consultation for the 2023-2027 Southwold Strategic Plan, Southwold residents identified municipal infrastructure as the main priority. It was recently announced that the Shedden and Fingal Sanitary Sewer project, underway since 2017, is now being supported by \$28.7 million dollars of Provincial funding from the Housing-Enabling Water System Fund.

The funding will support Southwold infrastructure priorities through Provincial investment, which would otherwise be entirely paid by local developer connection fees.

A variety of housing types will be available through this growth, expected to take place over a 20- year period. The provincial funding supports Southwold's goal of providing homes for young families in our community and allowing retirees to age in place. In addition to residential growth, the infrastructure will assist in revitalizing Shedden and Fingal downtowns and enabling more commercial development.

The Township is committed to transparent communication. Resident engagement will be implemented throughout the construction and prescribed planning processes. For questions, contact the Township at 519-769-2010.

**PLEASE DO NOT FLUSH

A reminder to be careful what you flush.

Wet wipes, paper towels and facial
tissues can clog pipes. We would
like to remind residents not to flush
wet wipes of any kind. Despite what
some packaging says, wipes are not
flushable. Paper towels and facial
tissues also do not belong in the
toilet. These items cannot be
flushed because they do not break
down like toilet paper does.
If wipes, paper towels and facial
tissues are flushed, they can cause
blockages in pipes – which may lead
to sewage overflows.
